of County Road #771.)

ORDER

WHEREAS the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners received a petition from Mervin Leonard and others to Relocate a portion of County Road #771. Said portion to be Relocated is described as follows:

Beginning at the $N\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 23, Township 3 North, Range 28 East, W.M.; thence $S 59^{\circ} 21' W$, 1,554 feet; thence $S 56^{\circ} 19' W$, to the northerly boundary of Oregon State Highway #320.

WHEREAS the above described portion of County Road #771 will be Relocated along the following described centerline having a 50 (fifty) foot right-of-way:

Beginning at the $N\frac{1}{4}$ corner of Section 23, Township 3 North, Range 28 East, W.M.; thence running Southerly along the North-South centerline of said Section 23 to the $S\frac{1}{4}$ corner common to Sections 23 and 26, Township 3 North, Range 28 East, W.M.; thence Southerly along the North-South centerline of Section 26 to it's intersection with Oregon State Highway #320.

WHEREAS the Umatilla County Board of Commissioners held a Hearing on July 16, 1975, and

WHEREAS all remonstrances against the Relocating of the above described portion of County Road #771 have been satisfied, and

WHEREAS a deed for the Relocated right-of-way has been received from Mervin Leonard, and

WHEREAS a report from the Umatilla County Roadmaster was received indicating this road relocation would be in the best interest of Umatilla County, now therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Relocating of a portion of County Road #771 as described above be granted and the new right-of-way as described in that deed received from Mervin Leonard be declared a portion of County Road #771 and will henceforth be maintained as a part of the Umatilla County Road System.
