Now on this day there is presented to the Court a Warranty deed signed by C.A. Johnson and Marie E. Johnson for a strip of land 50 feet wide as follows; 30 feet wide on each side of a line commencing at the N.E. corner or $SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. 11, Tp. 1 N.R. 31 E.W.M. running thence South 54 degrees West 4.90 chains, thence North 75 degrees 20' West 6.50 chains thence South 70 degrees West 6.69 chains, thence South 54 degrees 35' W 13.12 chains, thence S. 74 degrees 40' W. 13.48 chains, to a point N. 11 degrees W. 4.92 chains, distant from the center of sec. 11 Tp. 1 N.R. 31 E.W.M. and the Court being satisfied that said deed is a good and sufficient deed and is properly executed and that C.A. Johnson and wife are the owners of the land embraced therein,

It is hereby ordered that said deed be accepted and that said route be declared a County Road and that said deed be recorded in the records plats and field notes of Umatilla County and also by the recorder of Conveyances and that the fees ordinarily charged for the recording of such instrument be abated.
