In the Matter of a change in County Road No 134 petitioned for by Frank Sloan, Lina Archibald, and T. D. Matthews, Order.

Now on this day comes the report of William McCarty, O. J. Thomson, and S. W. Wattenburger, heretofore appointed at a previous day of this term of Court, to view out, survey, locate and report upon a proposed change in County Road No, 134 and the same at this time coming on for final hearing and said viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishing of the same as a County Road and the field notes and plat of survey being duly on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same and there being no remonstrance or claim for damages on file, against said road and the costs of viewers and surveyor having been paid by petitioners, as by law required,

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the report of said viewers be accepted, and that the said road be established as a County Road, in accordance with the report of viewers and that the field notes and plat of survey thereof be duly recorded as by law required and the road ordered opened, when it has been put in good condition for travel by petitioners.

In the matter of the payment of bounty for Coyotes, Wild cat, Mountain Lion, Panther, Cougar, Gray Wolf or Timber wolf Order.

Now on this day it is ordered by the Court that the Clerk of this Court be and he is hereby ordered, not to audit or issue County warrants in payment of bounties on any wild cat Coyote, Mountain Lion panther Cougar, grey wolf or timber wolf until the further order of this Court so to do.

In the matter of the distruction of Coyote scalps and scalps of other wild animals for which bounties are paid Order.

Chamberlain County Clerk of Umatilla County and presents to the Court a statement of scalp bounty claims paid by the County Clerk, during the months of September and October, 1902, and the Court having examined the same and having found it correct in all things and the scalps having been reduced to ashes it is hereby ordered that said report be, and the same is, hereby in all things approved,
