In the Matter of the Report of the Board of County Road Viewers on Road No 702, petitioned for by A W Stine et al commencing in Cherry St Milton, Oregon.

ROAD NO. 702

Now on this day comes William Nichols, Louis Tinn, Higby Harris, S F Harrington and Joe West, through their attorneys Raley & Raley and protests and remonstrates against the acceptance, approval or adopting of the report of the Board of County road viewers heretofore filed herein in the above entitled matter by Geary Kimbrell, County Surveyor, W J Stockman and L C Rothrock, acting as the Board of County Road Viewers and the court having duly considered the matter

It is hereby ordered that said objections and remonstrance, be and the same is hereby overruled.

In the Matter of the Report of the Board of County Road Viewers on Road No 702, petitioned for by A W Stine et al commencing in Cherry St. Milton, Oregon.

ROAD NO. 702

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the July 1911 term of this court to re-survey, stake, layout and report upon said proposed road No. 702, petitioned for as follows: Beginning at a point where Cherry St in Nichols' Second Addition to Milton, Oregon crosses the southerly boundary line of Milton City, running thence southeasterly along the line of Cherry Street to the westerly bank of the Walla Walla river, 100 rods more or less to the mouth of Couse creek, thence nearly South along the East bank of Couse creek about 200 rods to the center of the NW 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Sec 19 Tp 5 N R 36 E W M., thence southeasterly along the gulch to intersect of present County road at a point 250 ft East of the NW corner of the SW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec 33 Tp 5 N R 36 and to be 40 ft wide as a County road for final hearing, which said report being signed and returned by Geary Kimbrell, by John W Kimbrell, County Surveyor and W J Stockman and L C Rothrock, acting as Board of County road Viewers and the said report having been publicly read on two different days of the same term of court, to-wit: having been publicly read the first time on September 8th, 1911 and publicly read the second time on September 9th, 1911 and continued until this date. And the said Board of County road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor who surveyed the same and the court being satisfied that said road would be of sufficient public utility

It is therefore hereby ordered that said report of the board of County road Viewers as the same is returned and signed Geary Kimbrell, by John W Kimbrell, Deputy County Surveyor, W J Stockman and L C Rothrock as viewers, be approved and that said road be accepted as a County road and that the plat and field notes be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County and that the road supervisor through whose district said road runs be and is hereby ordered to open said road for public use.

In the Matter of a right-of-way deed signed by W W Whitworth et al

Now on this day there is presented to the court a deed to a certain piece of land which deed is signed by W W Whitworth, Mary E Whitworth, Sallie C Elder, E E Elder, Joseph Ramos and Mary Ramos and deeding a strip of land 40 ft. in width being 20 ft. on each side of and parallel with center line described and located as follows: said center line beginning at the City limits of the City of Echo, Oregon, at the South end of an unnamed street in said City of Echo, Oregon, at a point 10 ft East of the SW corner of 1/4 of SE 1/4 Sec 16, Tp 3 N R 29 E W M., thence South 31° 45' East 20 ft. distant from and appralled with the O W R & N Co's right-of-way, 2516 ft and 4 inches, more or less, to intersect of County Road at the East line of the NE 1/4 Sec. 21 Tp 3 N R 2 E W M and the court being satisfied that said deed of conveyance is properly executed

It is therefore hereby ordered that the land described in said deed be accepted as a County road and that the same be recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Umatilla County and that the fees ordinarily due such official for the recording of such instruments be and the same is hereby ordered
