To the Honorable, the above entitled Court:

The petition of John Leedy respectfully shows:

I.

That the residence of your petitioner situated in the Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty-one, Township One, North of Range Thirty-two, E. W.M. in Umatilla County, Oregon, is not reached by any public road heretofore provided by law, or by any road except by passing over and through the property of others at a great inconvenience to your petitioner, and contrary to the desire of the owners of the lands over which the road now used passes; that it is necessary that the public and your petitioner have a road for ingress and egress to and from said residence from a public county road, and that a road of public easement should be by this Court ordered to run as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the Northwest Corner of Section Twenty-one in Township One North of Range Thirty-two E. W. M., thence running West between Sections Seventeen and Twenty a distance of one-half mile to that certain county road known as No. 161 running from Pendleton to Pilot Rock, to a point thereon designated as the Northwest Corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section Twenty in said Township and Range, the land upon either side of said proposed road being owned by Julius Gudarien and J. W. Newquist, so far as your petitioner is advised.

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II.

That your petitioner resides with his family on said Northwest Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty-one, Township One, North of Range Thirty-two, the same being his homestead, and that there is no public road within a half a mile thereof, and that your petitioner is entitled to such an order as is herein prayed for under the law.

III.

That this Court should direct and appoint a board of County Road Viewers for Umatilla County, Oregon, to view said proposed road and cause an order to be issued directing them to meet at a time to be by the Court specified, not less than ten days from the making of such order, and to locate a county road thirty feet wide from the residence of the petitioner to the public road above described, and should direct that the said board assess damages, if any there be, and authorize a copy of said order to be served upon all persons through whose land said road shall pass, within four days from the making of such order.

WHEREFORE, your petitioner prays that a county road, to-wit, a road of public easement, thirty feet wide, be viewed, located, laid out, and established in accordance with the law of Oregon in such case provided, from the residence of this petitioner over the most practicable route to the County road above described, said road to commence at the Northwest Corner of Section Twenty-one, Township One, North of Range Thirty-two, E. W. M. thence running westerly between Sections Seventeen and Twenty, said township and range, a distance of one-half mile to that certain county road known as No. 161 running from Pendleton to Pilot Rock, and to a point thereon at or near the Northwest Corner of the Northeast Quarter of Section Twenty in said Township and Range, and for an order in consonance with this petition directing

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and appointing a board of county road viewers for Umatilla County, Oregon, to meet at a time and place to be in such order specified, and proceed to view out and locate a county road thirty feet wide from the petitioner's residence to said public road, and to assess damages, if any, and to direct a copy of said order to be served upon said Julius Gudarien and J. W. Newquist and any other person who may own lands through which said road shall pass, within four days from the making of such order, and such other orders as may be meet in the premises.
