In the Matter of opening County Road No 761 petitioned for By Gust Beilka, et al.

ROAD NO. 761

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard, upon the report of the board of County Road Viewers, heretofore instructed at the February, 1914, term of this Court to view, survey and report upon said road No. 761 petitioned for as commencing on the range line 28 rods South of the Northwest corner of Sec. 18 Tp. 1 N.R. 32 E.W.M. thence North along the Range line a distance of 1 mile and 28 rods to the Northwest corner of section 7, Tp. 1 N.R. 32 E.W.M. as a County road for final hearing, the same having been publicly read the first time on March 4th, 1914 and publicly read the 2nd time on March 5th, 1914 and the said plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor who surveyed the same and the said board of County Road viewers having reported favorably and recommended that said road be established and declared a public highway of Umatilla County, and there being no remonstrance or objections on file against said report or petition,

It is hereby ordered that said report be approved and that said road be declared a public highway of Umatilla County and the plat and field notes be recorded in the record of plats and field notes of Umatilla County, and that the road supervisor through whose district said road runs be and he hereby ordered and instructed to open said road to public use.

In the Matter of County Road petitioned for by R.M. Warren et al commencing 60 rods S.E. from N.W. Corner NE 1/4 Sec. 10 Tp. 2 N.R. 30 E.W.M.

Road No. 762

Now On this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the petition of R.M. Warren and 17 other freeholders who are residents of the road district or road districts wherein the hereinafter described and proposed county road is to be laid out, praying this court to lay out and establish a county road commencing at a point on the County Road 60 rods S.E. from the NW corner of the NE 1/4 of Section 10, Tp. 2 N.R. 30 E.W.M. at a post set in the ground marked R, thence in a southeasterly direction on the most practical route to a point on the County Road 230 yards Southwest from the center of section 8 Tp. 1 N.R. 31 E.W.M. and it duly appearing to the Court that due notice of the presentation of said petition has been given by the posting of three notices in the vicinity of said road and also by the posting of a notice on the bulletin board at the North Door of the County Court house in Pendleton, Oregon, the place of holding the County Court, all as by law required. And there being no remonstrance on file,

It is hereby ORDERED that the board of County Road viewers to-wit: John W. Kimbrell Deputy County Surveyor of Umatilla County as surveyor and L.O. Rothrock and W.A. Stockman as viewers, be and are hereby ordered and instructed to meet in Pendleton, Oregon on the 23rd day of March, 1914, or if unable to meet on that day, then within five days thereafter, all proceed to view, survey, stake and lay out said proposed road and estimate the cost of opening the same and make due return of their doings to the Court at its next regular term.

In the Matter of the County Road petitioned for by Allen H. Moore et al, Commencing at the NE corner Sec. 11 To. 2 N.R. 28 E.W.M.

ROAD NO. 763

Now on this day this matter coming on regularly to be heard upon the petition of Allen H. Moore and 27 other freeholders who are residents of the road district or road districts wherein the hereinafter described and proposed county road is to be laid out, praying this court to cause to be laid out and established a county road commencing at the Northwest corner of Sec. 11, Tp. 2 N.R. 28 E.W.M. thence running South on the section line between sections 11 and 12 and sections 13 and 14 on the most practical route to the Southeast corner of section 14 in said township and range, thence west on the section line between sections 14 and 23 to the S.W. corner of section 14 in said township and range to intersect the present County Road at said point. And it duly appearing to the Court that due notice of the presentation of said petition has been given by the posting of 3 notices in the vicinity of said proposed road and also by the posting of a notice on the bulletin board at the North door of the County Court House in Pendleton, Oregon, the place of holding the County Court, all as by law required. And there being no remonstrance or objections on file,

It is hereby ORDERED that the board of County Road viewers, to-wit: John W. Kimbrell Deputy County Surveyor of Umatilla County as surveyor and L.O. Rothrock and W.A.
