And it also appearing to the Court that the viewers heretofore appointed to view out and report upon the location of the above mentioned road, duly made their report at the Sept Term 1887 of this Court, and that said viewers reported favorably and recommend the location of the same as a County Road, and the field notes and plat of survey of said road being duly on file and certified to by the Surveyor appointed to survey the same,

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the report of said viewers be accepted, and that the road be established in accordance with said report, and that the report of said viewers, field notes, and plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required, upon payment by the petitioners herein to said John Allen or his Attorney the sum of Thirty (\$30<sup>00</sup>) Dollars as awarded him as damages by the said viewers N. Daughtrey, J. S. McLeod and Wm Martin and the satisfaction of said sum having been paid, to be filed with the Clerk of this Court by the petitioners herein.

And that upon said satisfaction of the payment of said damages being filed as ordered, the Road Supervisors through whose District said road runs be directed to open the same for public use as a County Road.
