Now on this day this matter coming regularly to be heard upon the report of the Board of County Road Viewers heretofore instructed at the July 1908 Term of this Court to view, survey and report upon said proposed road No. 660, commencing in a public wagon road at the NE corner of Section 36, Township 1 North, Range 31, E. W. M., and running thence one mile South to the SE corner of said Section 36; thence West about 40 rods to the NE corner of Section 1, Township 1 South, Range 31, E. W. M.; thence South 160 rods to the SE corner of the NE 1/4 of said Section 1; thence East 80 rods to the NE corner of the West half of the Southwest quarter of Section 6, Township 1 South, Range 32, E. W. M.; thence South 160 rods to the SE corner of said West half of the SW 1/4 of Section 6, and to be 40 feet wide as the County for final hearing the same having been publically read on two different days of the same term of Court, to-wit:

Having publically read the first time on August 6, 1908, and publically read the second time on August 7, 1908, and the said Board of County Road Viewers having reported favorably and recommended the establishment of said road as a public highway of Umatilla County, and the plat and field notes being on file and certified to by the surveyor appointed to survey the same and the Court being satisfied that said road would be a sufficient public utility, it is hereby Ordered that said report of the Board of County Road Viewers be approved and that the plat and field notes be recorded in the Records of Plats and Field Notes for Umatilla County and that the Road Supervisor through whose district said road runs be and he is hereby ordered and instructed to open said road for public use.
