

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County :

We, the undersigned your petitioners, who are residents and householders in Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located and established, a County road in said County and State commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit :

Commencing ^{To b} Where the East and West Section line, between Sections 11 and 14 of Township 2 S. and R. 31 East crosses the County road running from Rendleton to the John Day; thence running East on this section line 80 rods (more or less) to the bank of the brook, known as Birch Creek; from thence following this bank of the brook 80 rods (more or less) to the Dist. School house of Dist. No. 21. And from this point following the now traveled road along the creek 2 miles (more or less) to where the North and South Section line between sections No 29 and 30 of Township 2 S. and R. 32 E. crosses this Creek, and there terminating.

Said road to be Sixty feet wide.

And your petitioners will ever pray.
