In matter of County Road commencing
at a point where the County Road leading
from Pendleton to Pilot Rock crosses the
see line between Sec's 34 & 35 T¹ N. R
32 E. & ending at the dividing line be-
tween Amatilla & Union Counties near
the summit of the Blue Mountains }
Road N^o 186.

Now on this day it appearing to
the Court that the viewers heretofore appointed to view & report
upon the above mentioned road as a County Road have failed to meet
& report.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that the consideration of said
road be continued until the September 1884 term of this Court. & that
J. P. Finley, R. Alexander & W. F. Matlock be & they are hereby appointed
viewers & W. W. Caviness, Surveyor to view locate & survey said pro-
posed road as a County Road & that they report their doings therein at
the September 1884 term of this Court. & that they meet at the place of
beginning of said Road on the 24 day of July 1884 & duly qualify
before entering upon the discharge of their duties in this behalf.

In the matter of a change in the County
Road running from Tho. Ayers to Van
Arman's Saw Mill. said change to commence
opposite W. G. Salisbury's house near the 21
mile stake & connecting with the old
road again near the 23rd mile stake }
Road N^o 189.
above G. DeGraves house

Now on this day comes the report
of the viewers appointed at the April 1884 term of this Court, to view out
& report upon said change in above mentioned County Road. for final
hearing, the same having been read on a previous day of this term of this
Court, to-wit: July term 1884 & the viewers having reported favorably
& recommending the establishing of the same as a County Road, & the
field notes & plat of survey being duly on file & certified to by the Surveyor
appointed to survey the same. & there being no remonstrance on file
against said road.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said change in the above
mentioned County Road be established as a County Road in accordance
with the report of said viewers. & that the report of said viewers, field
notes & plat of survey thereof be recorded as by law required and the

open the same for public use as a County Road.

Now on this day it appearing to the Court
that a Remonstrance ^{and} affidavit has been filed, stating to the Court
that J. E. M^r. Quary, the person appointed Justice of the Peace for Centerville
Precinct on a previous day of this term, that he the said J. E. M^r. Quary is
not a Citizen of the State of Oregon, having resided in said State only for
the last two months.

It is therefore ordered by the Court that said appointment be
reconsidered ^{and} that the appointment of said J. E. M^r. Quary as Justice
of the Peace in ^{and} for Centerville Precinct, be revoked.

Whereupon Court adjourned until to-morrow morning
at 9.00 clock.
