In the matter of the location of a County road }
 Commencing at the county road running }
 through the town of Mt Pleasant on }

Now on this day comes a petition for the location of a county road commencing at the County road running through the town of Mount Pleasant and up Birch Creek to Byrds Saw mill at a point between the school House near said town and the store house formerly occupied by O. H. Wilson as a store house thence running along the old road usually traveled from said town of Mt Pleasant to Pilot Rock to the intersection of the County road leading from Pendleton to Pilot Rock at a point near where the old store house of A. J. Sturtevant stands

It appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that the law has been complied with in the premises.

It is now therefore ordered by the court that Charles Craig, L. L. Lewis and Weston Green be and are hereby appointed viewers to meet at Alta on the 5th day of July 1875 or within five days thereafter and proceed in company with the County Surveyor, to view, survey, mark out and locate said proposed road, as prayed for in petition and report to this Court, at April term 1875.

Now on this day comes viewers report for a second reading, and said report having been read in open Court on two different days of the same meeting and there being no remonstrance, or bill of damages on file. It is now therefore ordered by the court that said road be and is hereby established as a county road in accordance with viewers report, field notes and plat now on file. and it is further ordered that the supervisors of said road be and are hereby required to open and keep said road in good repair.
