

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla
County:

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are residents and householders in
Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described
route for a County road, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out,
located and established, a County road in said County and State, commencing, running
and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the 36th

Commencing at the 36th mile post on road
No 277 on the town plat of Alba, thence
in a general south easterly course on or
near the present travelled road to the
Northwest ^{corner} of section N. T-5-S-R-32-E-W.M.

Thence easterly on the most practical route
to the old road grade, ^{and} down ^{that} to Camas
Creek bottoms, Thence up Camas creek
to the Bowman sheep dip. Thence along
a road or trail already opened by the
Teal Springs to the east line of
Umatilla county, to a certain Pine
Tree flag on four sides at or near the summit

Said road to be sixty feet wide, from section 4.

And your petitioners will ever pray.
