To The Honorable County Court,
County of Umatilla, Oregon.

Gentleman:

Pursuant to your request and letter of August 15th, and signed by Mrs. E.B. Casteel, County Clerk of Umatilla County, we your road viewers proceeded to Lehman Springs on August 20th, 1938 and did view the road as requested in the above recited communication.

After walking over the proposed site of the location we beg to report to your Honorable Body as follows.

- 1st. The new location is practicable and will afford a much better ingress and egress to Lehman Springs than is afforded by the present road.
- 2nd. In looking over the new location it was our opinion that no damages would accrue and it is our recommendation that no damages for Right Of Way be allowed.
- 3rd. The new location is mostly covered with pole pine (Black Pine of small diameter) and before construction is started a survey should be made that proper curves and grades shall be maintained.
- 4th. It is our recommendation that this road of approximately 1.50 miles be surveyed and constructed.
