

To the Honorable County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County.

WE, THE UNDERSIGNED, your petitioners, who are residents and householders in Umatilla County, Oregon, and who reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, respectfully petition your honorable body to cause to be laid out, located and established, a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing Eighty rods west of the center of Section four (4) Twp. (3) line S. R. (32) thirty two East W.M., thence one and one fourth miles west; thence one fourth miles south, thence one half ($\frac{1}{2}$) mile west; thence one quarter ($\frac{1}{4}$) mile south, thence one mile west, thence about (200) two hundred rods south, to the present traveled road, thence along the traveled road to intersect with the east end of Well Street in ^{the} town of Ukiah.

Said road to be 40 feet wide.

And your petitioners will ever pray.
