

# ROAD NOTICE.

TO ALL PERSONS WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Notice is hereby given that a petition will be presented to the County Court of the State of Oregon, for Umatilla County, by the undersigned, who are residents and householders of said County and State and reside in the vicinity of the hereinafter described route for a County road, at the Nov. term, 1895, of said County Court, to-wit: On the 4<sup>th</sup> day of Nov., 1895, praying said Court to lay out, locate and establish a County road in said County and State, commencing, running and terminating as follows, to-wit: Commencing at the S.E. corner of the N.E. quarter of the S.W. quarter of Sec. 14 Tp. 5, S.R. 31 E.W.M., thence running to a point about 585 feet West and 130 feet South to South end of New Bridge, across Big Camas Creek, thence Northerly across said Bridge, and then the most practicable route to the South end of Camas Street in Merist, Oregon.

Also, to vacate part of road No. 449, from said beginning point of proposed road to South end of Alpha Street in Merist, Oregon, Also, to lay out and establish a road from the South end of New Bridge in a Southerly direction on the most practicable to the North end of Bridge over Little Camas Creek on the John Day Road near Charles Vinson's residence, Said road to be 40 feet wide.
