Commencing at the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec cor bet sec 15 and 16
S 5 S 16 32 E W M set post 4 ft long 4 ins dia
24 ins in the ground 30 feet East of initial point
Marked R No 572 raised mound of stone 18 ins high
4 ft wide at base around post
Thence South bet sec 15 & 16
2700 creek 10 ft wide no wet
4000 the corner to sec 15-16-21 and 22
5600 creek to right course $N 20^{\circ} W$
5700 front bank of creek course W
6140 foot of Hill ascend
6400 top of Hill thence gradual ascent $+ 35'$
8000 to $\frac{1}{4}$ sec corner bet sec 21 and 22
set stone 24 x 18 x 10 marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S 5 S No 572
and raised mound of stone 18 ins high 3 ft wide at base
around stone
