



**NARRATIVE:**

The purpose of this survey was to survey that parcel as described on Roll 50, Page 1530 of the Umatilla County Deed Records, in the North portion of Block O, Reservation Addition to the City of Pendleton.

The North, South, East and West line are based upon the original plat bearings and distances and a survey by W.E.O. Griger of Blocks 157 and O. Pins, railroad spike and the monument RB14 were found and used in a survey for Fletcher Oil Co. in 1972 by Wayne Harris Co.

Bearings are true and are based upon ties to U.S.G.S. station "Pendleton".
