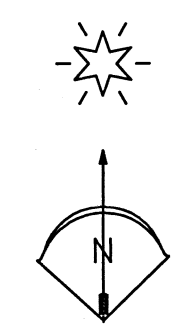

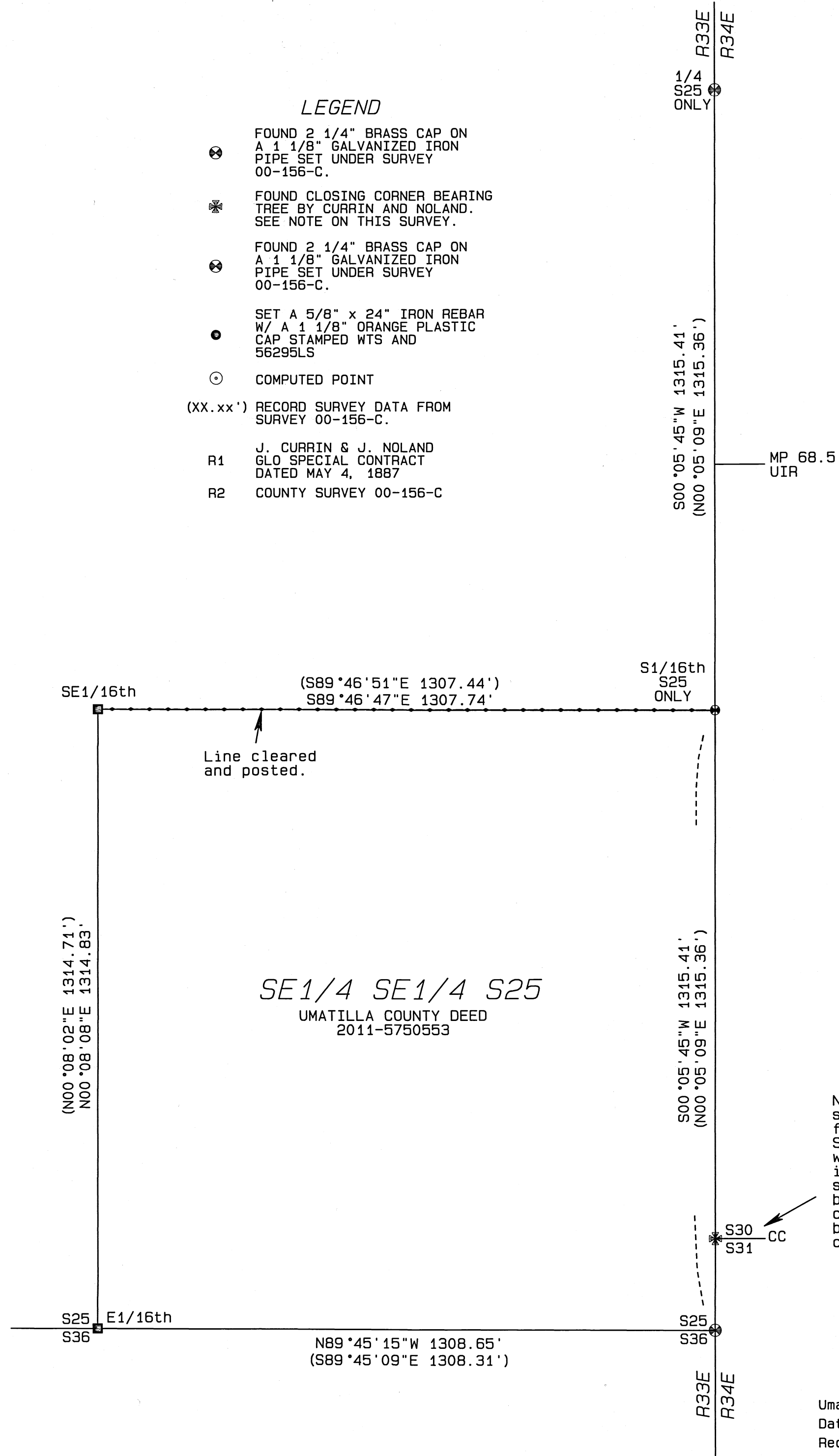


NARRATIVE OF SURVEY

This survey was performed at the request of Mr. Kelly Bensel. The purpose of the survey was to locate and monument the south 1/16th of Section 25 on the township line and to clear and post the north line of the SE1/4 of the SE1/4 of section 25 in preparation for fencing and a timber thinning operation.

This section was previously subdivided by survey 00-156-C. I found the monuments from that survey in good condition and undisturbed and therefore held them as controlling for this survey. I calculated the location of the south 1/16th on the township line at midpoint between the SE corner and E quarter corner of section 25 as directed by the 2009 BLM Manual of Instructions. I also found the bearing tree for the closing corner to sections 30 and 31 which I do not need for this survey. However, as the closing corner to sections 30 and 31 was only a post and is gone and one bearing tree is dead and gone and the other is now dead, I report its location in relation to the SE corner of S25 as an effort to preserve that point and as required by ORS209.250(9).

Control for this survey was tied with a Trimble R7/R8 RTK GPS system and the property line run and cleared with a Trimble 5601 electronic total station running between points established by GPS survey.



Note: The original GLO record calls the southeast bearing tree for this corner "a fir, 36 ins. diam., -- marked CC T2S R34E S31 BT". I find a 36" Ponderosa Pine snag with an open double blaze. The upper blaze is scribed RCC and the lower blaze is scribed BT. The center of the lower blaze bears N5°55'17"E 178.75 feet from the SE corner of Section 25. The center of the BT bears N6°20'03"E 178.16 feet from the SE corner of Section 25.

BASIS OF BEARINGS
