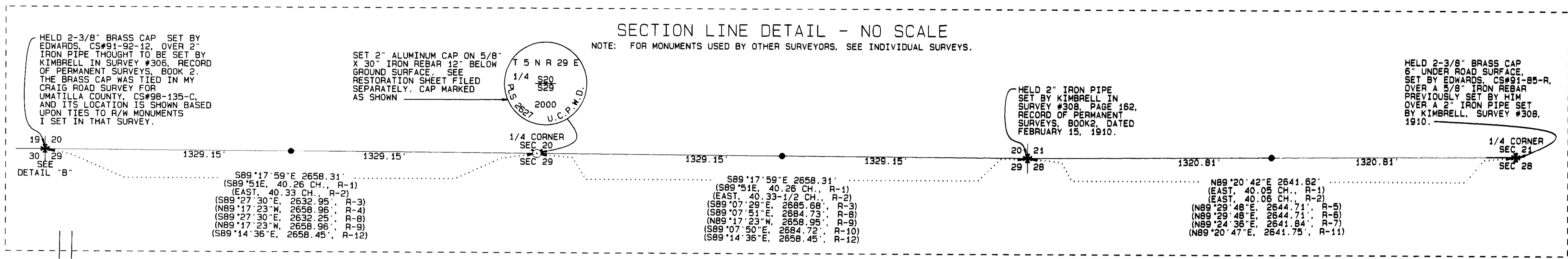


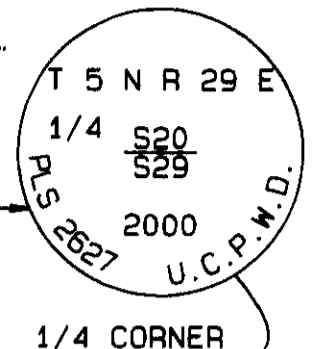
SECTION LINE DETAIL - NO SCALE

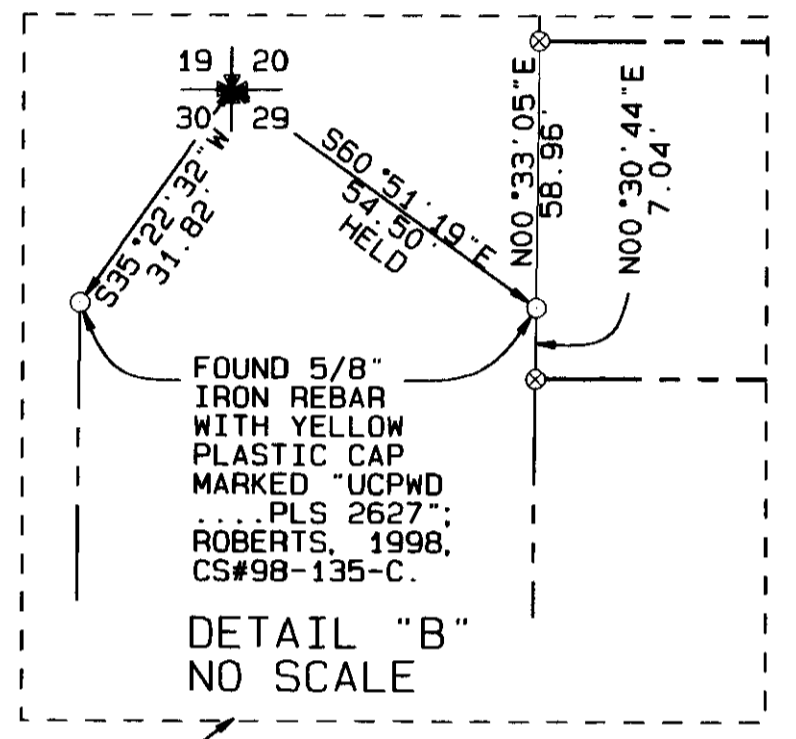
HELD 2-3/8" BRASS CAP SET BY EDWARDS, CS#91-92-12, OVER 2" IRON PIPE THOUGHT TO BE SET BY KIMBRELL IN SURVEY #308, RECORD OF PERMANENT SURVEYS, BOOK 2. THE BRASS CAP WAS TIED IN MY CRAIG ROAD SURVEY FOR UMATILLA COUNTY, CS#98-135-C, AND ITS LOCATION IS SHOWN BASED UPON TIES TO R/W MONUMENTS I SET IN THAT SURVEY.

SET 2" ALUMINUM CAP ON 5/8" X 30" IRON REBAR 12" BELOW GROUND SURFACE. SEE RESTORATION SHEET FILED SEPARATELY. CAP MARKED AS SHOWN.

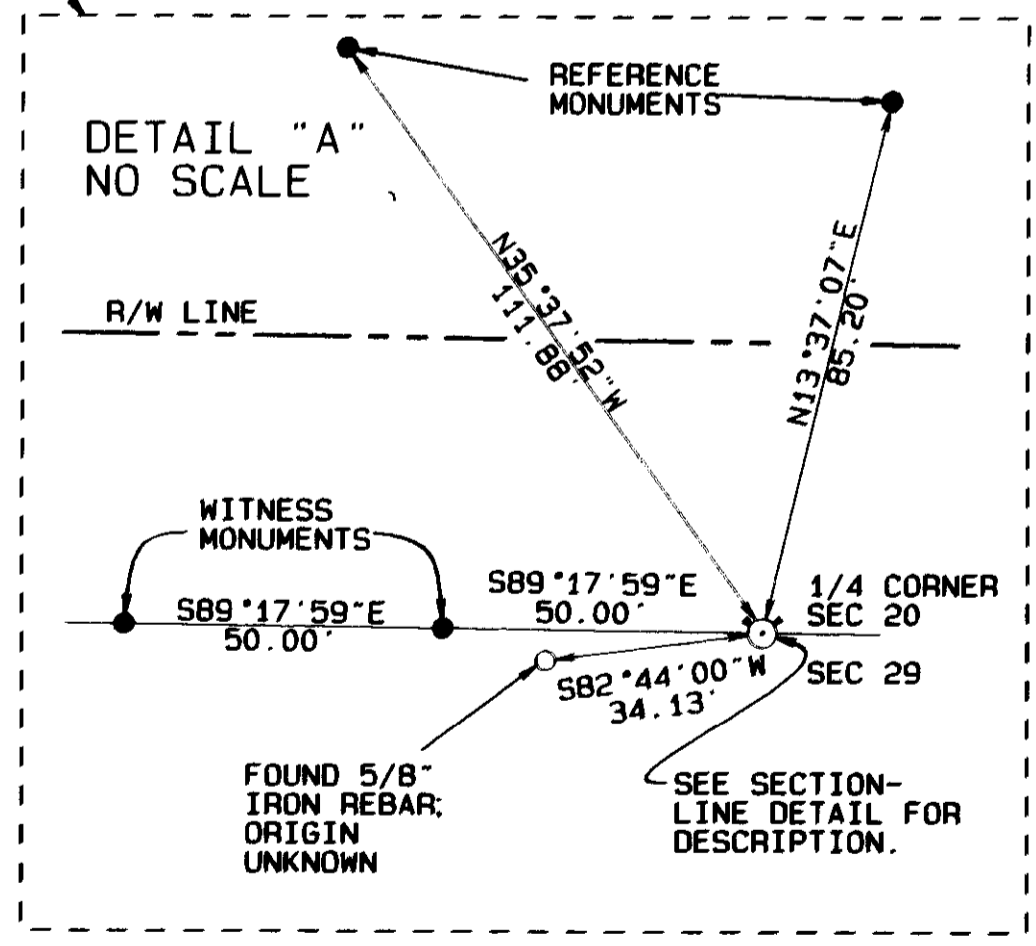

SURVEY NARRATIVE

THE PURPOSE OF THIS SURVEY WAS TO MONUMENT THE CENTERLINE OF THAT PORTION OF COUNTY ROAD #1268 (PROGRESS ROAD) BETWEEN CRAIG ROAD AND GOLDA ROAD AND SHOW THE LOCATIONS OF FENCE LINES, CULTIVATED AREAS, UTILITIES, TRAVELED ROADS, AND OTHER IMPROVEMENTS. THIS PORTION OF PROGRESS ROAD IS AN UNDEVELOPED RIGHT-OF-WAY AND THE LEGAL CENTER OF THE RIGHT-OF-WAY IS THE SECTION LINE. THE SURVEY IS BEING MADE AT THE REQUEST OF THE UMATILLA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS SO THEY CAN DETERMINE WHETHER TO ALLOW A FENCE TO BE CONSTRUCTED ALONG THE SECTION LINES BY THE ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS.

THE 1/16th CORNERS WERE MONUMENTED IN THIS SURVEY. AS WAS THE NORTH 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 29. MONUMENTS ON RIGHT-OF-WAY LINES WERE NOT SET AND ARE NOT SHOWN. A 5/8" REBAR FOUND NEAR THE SINGLE PROPORTION LOCATION OF THE 1/4 CORNER WAS NOT HELD, NOR WAS THE CALCULATED POSITION OF A 5/8" REBAR SET BY LAGIER IN 1979. KIMBRELL SET A PIPE AT THE LOCATION IN 1910, WHICH WAS NOT FOUND. KIMBRELL'S SINGLE-PROPORTION DISTANCE MATCHES DAVENPORT'S 1861 SINGLE PROPORTION DISTANCE WELL AND THE 1/4 CORNER WAS RESET BY SINGLE PROPORTION HOLDING A BRASS CAP REPORTEDLY SET OVER A KIMBRELL PIPE AT THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 29 AND A 2" IRON PIPE AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE SECTION SET BY KIMBRELL IN 1910.

BEARING BASE FOR THIS SURVEY IS THE CRAIG ROAD LEGALIZATION SURVEY I DID FOR UMATILLA COUNTY, COUNTY SURVEY #98-135-C, AS SHOWN. THIS SURVEY WAS PERFORMED USING A 2-PERSON CREW AND A WILD T-16 ONE MINUTE THEODOLITE CONNECTED TO A WILD DI-5 EDM.
