1881, Jacob C. Cooper, established a corner tree, a 3" thorn tree marked 1/4S on the east and west faces, from which;

28" balm bears S.80°W., 9.9 feet scribed per manual of instruction. no other trees within limits, raised a mound of stone alongside.

1989, Duane Griffith, PLS 644, set this 1/4 corner by single proportion.

Monument(s) & Accessories Found: (Condition and Source)

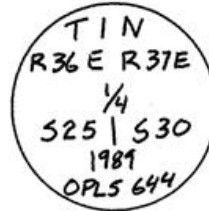
I found a 3-1/4" aluminum cap monument firmly set in a rock cairn, from which;

33" white fir bears N.45°E., 82.45 feet with scribing visible.

28" ponderosa pine bears S.29°W., 56.62 feet with scribing visible.

From the existing monument I established the following;

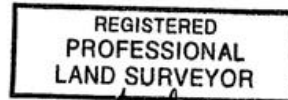
1-1/2" aluminum cap (PLS 2535) on a 5/8"x 24"rebar bears S.21°E., 12.3 feet, cap is stamped 12.3 RM with an arrow pointing toward the corner.

1-1/2" aluminum cap (PLS 2535) on a 5/8"x 24"rebar bears N.83-1/2°W., 9.4 feet, cap is stamped 9.4 RM with an arrow pointing toward the corner.

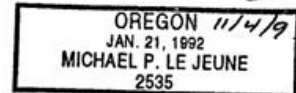
