MONUMENT SET:

Held railroad tie fence corner with fences South and West as best remaining evidence of original corner position. There are remains of a fence extending East, (rock jacks). A old abandoned power pole line runs East-West through this corner, (evidenced by old glass insulators and wood pole cross arms, and a few standing abandoned power poles). At a point just North of the railroad tie fence corner set A 1 1/4" x 30" galvanized iron pipe with a 2 3/8" brass cap, 24" in the ground and surrounded with earth and stone. Monument marked as shown in Monument Marking Detail.

A $5/8" \times 24"$ iron rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372", bears South 56° East, 41.9 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rebar in fence line with yellow plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372", bears South, 36.2 feet.

A 3/4" brass washer stamped "PLS 1106" 1 foot above ground level in a abandoned power pole North 82° West, 24.9 feet.

A 5/8" x 24" iron rebar with yellow plastic cap stamped "OR PLS 1106, WA PLS 17372", bears North 31° West, 57.5 feet.

Attached bearing object signs to rebar accessories and abandoned power pole with brass washer. Attached witness sign to railroad tie by monument.
