Evidence Found: Found 18" long boot shaped stone 5" by 4" top and 10" by 14" firmly set 14" in the ground, small end up, with a charcoal deposit under it. The stone was located on the remains of an east-west fence. The stone was 7 chains east of the head of a draw going north towards the Umatilla River. Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner: I set a 1.25" O.D. x 30" galvanized iron pipe with 2.25" brass cap stamped as shown in the diagram above. The pipe was set 24" in the ground. Constructed stone collar around the monument. Set a 6' steel fence post with Umatilla County Land Survey Monument sign attached from which: a rebar bears S15°17'53"W, 45.90": a rebar bears \$83°08'28"E, 47.11"; a rebar bears N79°27'38"W, 49.38"; a rebar bears N15°02'12"E, 46.94'. Each rebar is 5/8" x 24" and has a 1.25" diameter red plastic cap, stamped ORLS0852 and WALS13922. The bearings are true based on GPS observations. This work was done April 30, 1997.
