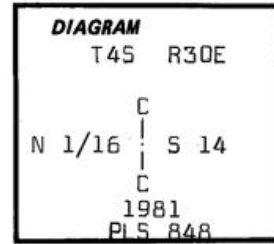


CERTIFIED RECORD OF LAND CORNER MONUMENTATION

Description of monument and accessories I established to perpetuate the original location of this corner:

Set 3"x30" galv. iron pipe with 3" brass cap stamped as shown on the diagram, set 24 inches in the ground.

From which:

A pine 16 in. dia. bears N71°W, 29.5 ft. scribed CN 1/16 S 14 BT.

A pine 14 in. dia. bears S19°E, 69.3 ft. scribed CN 1/16 S 14 BT.

Set steel post with warning and boundary signs 5 ft. West and 4 ft. East from corner. Nailed bearing tree signs and brass washers stamped PPLs 848 to each tree. Painted red band around each tree.
