

Supplemental Survey of Subdivisional Lines, T. 1 N., R. 35 E.

Chains

Sec. 1.

I go to cor. of secs. 1, 12, 6 and 7 on the E. bdy. of the Tp. heretofore described.

Thence, I run

N. on E. bdy. of sec. 1.

Var. 18°30' East.

Along high ridge - no timber.

40.00 Could find no corner.

78.53 Intersect N. bdy. of Tp. 3 lks. W. of cor. of Tps. 1 and 2 N. Rs. 35 and 36 E., which is a post marked and witnessed as described by the Surveyor General.

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From the cor. above described, I run

S. 89° 48' W. for the fractional sec. cor. on the N. bdy. of sec. 1 on the U. I. R. bdy., which being in sight over high rolling prairie

26.00 Intersect the U. I. R. bdy. at the closing township corner, which is a basalt stone in a mound of stone.
