General Description.		
This Tp. is very much broken, about $\frac{1}{2}$ of it, being high table land, having 2nd rate soil producing good grass, making it suitable for grazing purposes.		
The remainder is mountainous, with soil varying from 2nd to 4th rate; rocky in places with grass on open ridges.		
The Tp. also contains some scattering pine and fir timber.
