

Township 3 North, Range 36 East

Chains

Pine Creek to the North.

The timber of small growth, considerable dead and fallen.

Undergrowth, thick, larch, fir & willows.

General Description

The South West corner of this Township is on the Umatilla Reservation, and all of that portion South of the Umatilla River, except immediately along the river bottoms is wholly unfit for settlement.

That portion on the North side will in time be settled. Nearly all of this portion is valuable for its timber. The farmers are cutting and drawing away large quantities of it for fencing and building purposes.

Consequently that portion should be subdivided and put into the market as soon as practicable in order that the government may have the benefit of the proceeds of the sale of such land and the adjacent farmers may secure a title to the timbered land, so that personal interest will prompt them to guard against unnecessary waste.

Survey of the Subdivisional Lines of Township 3 North, Range 36 E, Willamette Meridian, Oregon, by George S. Pershin, U. S. Deputy Surveyor, under his Contract No. 305, dated Sept. 20, 1878

For the purpose of comparing my running and chaining with that of the Exterior Boundaries of this Township, and also to ascertain if there are any material errors in the Survey of the Exterior Boundaries, I begin at the corner to Sections 1 and 12 on the East Boundary of this Township No. 3 North, Range 36 East; and with Burt's Improved Solar Compass, I carefully run and measure a blank line.

South along the East Boundary of section 12.

Va. 16° East.

To a point 5 lks. East of stone corner to Sections 12 and 13. Thence

South along the E. Boundary of Section 13.
