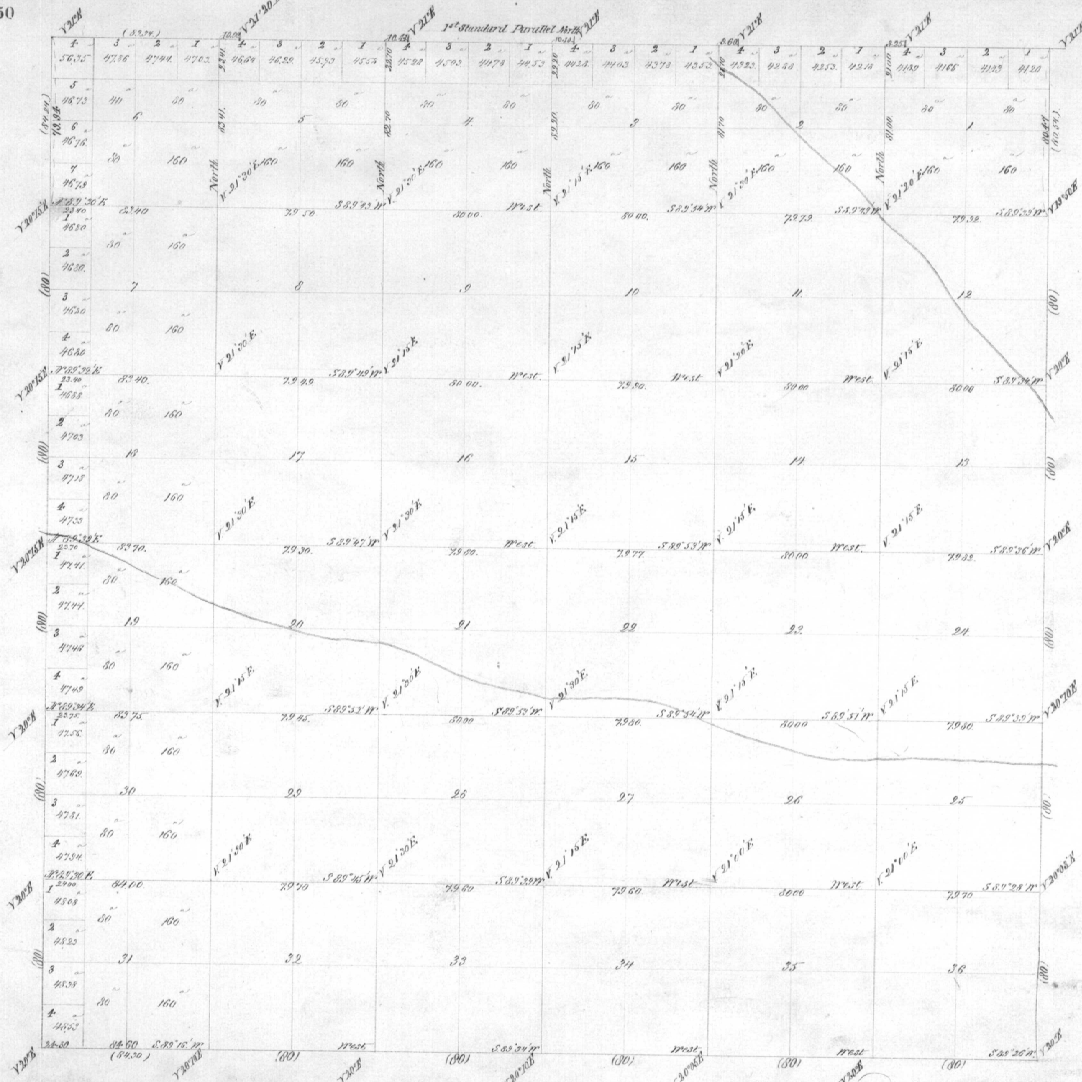

General Description
 The surface of this Township is level or gently rolling. The soil is generally of heavy loam.
 The grade on the natural line of the town is flat and thin but increases gradually toward the West. The Township is adapted to stock raising from convenient to the Columbia River on the North and to Wheat raising on the East.
 This Township has no water courses and no timber, being on what is known as "level" hills flat.
