Land; mountainous.

Soil; 2nd rate.

Densely covered with forests of pine, fir & tamarack,  
77.20 chs.

Thick undergrowth of small pine & fir, 77.20 chs.

General Description.

This Tp. is mountainous. The soil along the streams is of  
first rate quality. The land of the remaining portion
