has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit:

A strip of land 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of the center line of the survey as now surveyed; Beginning at a point which point is approximately 475 feet east and 30 feet south of the SW corner of the SE 1/4 of section 26, Twp 4N, Range 36, E. W.M. said point being station 160/60 on a 10° curve left; thence around the curve for a distance of 661 feet; thence along a tangent with approximate bearing of N 63°01' East for a distance of 279 feet to a point on the edge of old County right of way, which point is approximately 1365 feet east and 30 feet south of the above described corner, containing 1.31 acres more or less.

To Have and to hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
