paid them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land Sixty (60) feet wide, being Thirty (30) feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across the East one half of the Northeast one quarter

of Section 30 Township 3 North, Range 28 East T.M. Beginning at Station 290 $\frac{1}{2}$ 91 of the Butter Creek Highway Survey which Station is approximately 465 feet West of the Section Corner which is common to Sections 19-20-29 and 30 Township 3 North, Range 28 East T.M. Thence running in a Southwesterly direction approximately 2457 feet to Station 315 $\frac{1}{2}$ 48 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ 86 feet West and 320 feet North of the $\frac{1}{2}$ Section corner which is common to Sections 29 and 30 Township 3 North, Range 28 East T.M., containing 3.38 acres and no more.

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
