

In the Matter of Oregon Road,

Known as the Old Oregon Trail Highway

Known All Men by These Presents, That L. L. Mann and Lilly Mann, his wife,

Umatilla of the County of Umatilla, in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One Dollar paid them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land One Hundred (100) wide, being Fifty (50) feet on side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across

The North half of the Southeast quarter of Section 20 Township North Range 35 East W. M. Beginning at a point designated as station 1381 + 50 on said center line survey, said point being approximately 2308 feet west and 2546 feet south of the section corner common to sections 16, 17, 20 and 21 T 1 N. R. 35 E M; thence south 3 deg. 27' west a distance of 1600 feet to a point designated as station 1397 + 50 on said center line survey, said point being approximately 2404 feet west and 4143 feet south of the above described section corner. This parcel of land contains 3.04 acres, more or less.

In addition to the above described right of way this deed grants the privilege of obtaining addition road material from any point within 300 feet on either side of said center line survey. Provided no timber shall be removed from without the 100 foot right of way

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
