One Dollar paid them, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land One Hundred (100) wide, being Fifty (50) feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across

The Northeast quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 14 Township 1 South Range 35 East W. M. Beginning at a point designated as station 1674 / 12.1, said point being approximately 952 feet west and 418 feet north of the quarter corner between sections 11 and 14, T 1 S R 35 EWM; thence on a 1 degree curve to the right, whose tangent at above named point bears south 32 degrees 41' east, a distance of 916.7 feet; thence south 33 degrees 31' east a distance of 1169.3 feet; thence on a 4 degree curve to the right a distance of 338.3 feet to a point designated as station 1698 / 36.4, said point being approximately 43 feet east and 1785 feet south of the above described 1/4 corner. This parcel of land contains 3.29 acres, more or less.

In addition to the above described right of way this deed grants the privilege of obtaining additional road material from any point within 300 feet on either side of the above described center line survey.

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
