paid One, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, ha granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land 40 feet wide, being 20 feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of Section 28, Township 6

North, Range 35 East W.M., Beginning at Station 272+83.5 in the Sunnyside-Umapine Highway Survey which station is approximately 241.0 feet West of the Sec. Corner which is common to Sections 21, 22, 27 and 28 Township 6 North, Range 35 East W.M. Thence running in a Southeasterly direction approximately 377.2 feet to Station 276+60.7 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 241 feet South of the Sec. corner which is common to Sections 21, 22, 27 and 28 Township 6 North Range 25 East W.M.

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
