in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of Two Hundred Ten and 00/100 (\$210.00) Dollars paid to her, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, she granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit:

A strip of land 30 feet wide in the Northeast Quarter of Section 21, Township 4 North, Range 32 East, W. M., lying south of and adjacent to County Road No. 413, as the same is now opened and established, more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the point of intersection of the south line of County Road No. 413 and the North and South Quarter Section line through the center of said Section 21, thence Easterly following the said South line of County Road No. 413 to its intersection with the West line of County Road No. 2, thence South 30 feet, thence Westerly running 30 feet South of and parallel to the said South line of County Road No. 413, to the North and South Quarter Section line through the center of said Section 21, thence North 30 feet to the place of beginning. All in the Northeast Quarter of Section 21, Township 4 North, Range 32 East, W. M. Contains 1.4 acres more or less.

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
