The Southwest Quarter of Section 16 T.3.N.R. 32 E.W.M., said center line being more particularly described as follows; beginning at a point known as station 0 plus 43 on Unit # 2 of the Pendleton De Spain Gulch Highway said point being approximately 22 feet North of the Section corner common to sections 15, 16, 21 and 22 T.3.N.R.32 E.W.M., thence North a distance of 2568 feet to a point known as station 26 plus 11 on the above mentioned highway said point being approximately at the quarter corner between sections 15 and 16 T.3N.R.32 E.W.M. containing 1.77 acres more or less.

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
