The Northwest quarter of Section 27, Township 3 North, Range 32 East, W.M. said center line being more particularly described as follows; Beginning at the quarter Section corner common to Sections 27 and 28, thence North 2640 feet, more or less, to the Section Corner common to Sections 21, 22, 27 and 28. All in Township 3 North, Range 32 East W.M.

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
