M., running thence due West a distance of 61 feet; thence in a Northeasterly direction and parallel to and 30 feet East of a 6° 30' curve whose tangent at that point bears North 15° 06' East, a distance of 220.3 ft; thence due North approximately 2420 feet; thence due East 30 feet to the Quarter corner common to Section 27, 28 Twp. 3 N. R. 32 E. W. M.; thence due South approximately 2640 feet to place of beginning. Said parcel of land containing 1.90 acres more or less.
