Said center line being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at the Quarter Section Corner Common to Sections 27 and 28, thence North on the Section line common to said Sections 27 and 28, 2640 feet more or less to the Section-Corner Common to sections 21- 22- 27 and 28, all in Township 3 North, Range 32 East W. M.
