R. 30 E.W.M. within a strip of land 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of the center line of the Pendleton-Cold Springs Highway, as surveyed and staked across said property, said center line being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point known and designated as station 190 + 00, said point being approximately 1680 feet west and 2770 feet north of the section corner common to sections 20- 21- 28 and 29, Tp. 5 N. R. 30 E.W.M.; thence south 58° 26' east, a distance of 2200 feet to a point known and designated as station 212 + 00, said point being approximately 1618 feet north and 195 feet east of the section corner common to sections 29- 21- 28 and 29, Tp 5, N. R. 30 E.W.M. said parcel of land containing 2.44 acres, more or less.
