All that property of Frank Sloan and Claude Sloan in the SW¹/₄ of section ²¹ Tp 5 N. R. 30 E7W, within a strip of land 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of the center line of the Pendleton-Gold Springs Highway, as surveyed and staked across said property, said center line being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point known and designated as station 208+00, said point being approximately 1827 feet north and 145 west of the section corner common to sections 20, 21, 28 and 29 T. 5 N. R. 30 E7W; thence south 58° 26' a distance of 2725.4 feet; thence on a 6 degree curve to the right a distance of 674.6 feet to a point known and designated as station 242+00, said point being approximately 110 feet south and 2585 feet east of the section corner common to sections, 20, 21, 28; and 29 Tp 5 N. R. 30 E7W, said parcel of land containing 4.29 acres, more or less.
