Known as the Cold Springs - Pendleton Highway

Know All Men by These Presents, That Joseph F. Connally, an unmarried man,

of the County of Umatilla, in the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One Dollar paid him, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across

All the property of Joseph F. Connally in the NW 1/4 of the NE 1/4 of section 30, T 5 N R 31 E 1/2 W, within a strip of land 60 feet wide, being 30 feet on each side of the center line of the Pendleton Cold Springs Highway, as surveyed and staked across said property, said center line survey being more particularly described as follows: Beginning at a point on said center line survey known and designated as station 500 + 00, said point being approximately 93.0 feet south and 145.0 feet west of the section corner common to sections 24 and 25 T 5 N R 30 E 1/2 W and sections 19 and 30 T 5 N R 31 E 1/2 W; thence North 84° 55' east a distance of 131.7 feet; thence on an 8 degree curve to the left a distance of 335.0 feet to a point known and designated as station 504 + 62.8, said point being approximately 28 feet north and 300.0 feet east of the section corner common to sections 24 and 25 T 5 N R 30 E 1/2 W and sections 19 and 30 T 5 N R 31 E 1/2 W. said parcel of land containing 0.36 acres, more or less.

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
