Northeast Quarter of section 24 Tp 1 South Range 31 E.W.M, and northwest quarter, of Section 19 Township 1 South Range 31 East W.M.

Beginning at a point of the Oregon- Washington Highway Survey which Station id approximately 1035 feet west of the East $\frac{1}{4}$ Corner Sections 24 Township 1 South Range 31 East W.M. Thence running in a Northeasterly direction approximately 1235 feet to Station 647x00 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 400 feet North and 1320 feet east of the west $\frac{1}{4}$ corner Section 19 Township 1 South Range 32 E.W.M. said parcel of land containing 3.57 acres more or less.
