paid owner, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, ha granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey into the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land 40 feet wide, being 20 feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across S 1/2 SE 1/4 NE 1/4 NW 1/4 and NE 1/2 SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 14,

Township 4 North, Range 28 E. W.M. Beginning at Station 650 7 30 of the Old Oregon Trail Highway Survey which station is approximately 1977.4 feet East and 1073 feet South of the Section Corner which is common to Section 10-11-14-15 Township 4 N., Range 28 E. W.M. Thence running in a Southeasterly direction approximately 880 feet to Station 659 7 10 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 2640 feet East and 1642 feet South of the Section corner which is common to Sections 10-11-14-15 Township 4 N. Range 28 E. W.M. Area covered 0.8 acres.

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
