has granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit: A strip of land 60 feet wide, being 50 feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across Northeast one quarter (1/4) of Section 18,

Township 5 N. Range 28 East W.M. Beginning at sta. 200/86 of the Columbia River Highway Survey which station is approximately 40 feet North and 1320 feet West of the 1/4 Sec. Corner which is common to Sections 17 & 18 Township 5 N. Range 28 East W.M. Thence running in a Northeasterly direction approximately 542 feet to Station 206/30 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 179 feet North and 799 feet West of the 1/4 Sec. corner which is common to Sections 17 and 18 Township 5 North Range 28 East W.M.

To Have and to Hold the same, unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, for the purpose of a public road forever.
