Known as the Oregon-Washington Highway

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That Ross Land & Sheep Company, a Corporation of the State of Oregon, in consideration of the benefits and other valuable considerations, and the sum of One and no/100 Dollars, paid it, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and conveyed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the County of Umatilla, State of Oregon, the following described parcel of land, situate in Umatilla County, in the State of Oregon, to-wit:

A strip of land sixty feet wide, being thirty feet on each side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across Southwest quarter of Section 22 Township 1 S, Range 30 East W.M., beginning at a point of the Oregon-Washington Highway Survey which Station is approximately 490 feet South of the 1/4 corner which is common to Sections 21 and 22 Township 1 South, Range 30 East W.M. Thence running in a Southeasterly direction approximately 3358 feet to Station 65x70 of the said survey, which Station is approximately 858 feet North of the quarter corner which is common to Sections 22 and 27 Township 1 South Range 30 E.W.M. said parcel of land containing 4.62 acres, more or less.
