to-wit: A strip of land Sixty feet wide, being Thirty feet on each

side of the center line of said road, as surveyed over and across the Southwest quarter of Section 24, Town-

ship 1 S, Range 30 East W.M. Beginning at a point of the Oregon-Washington Highway

Survey which Station is approximately 28 feet South of the Section Corner which is

common to Sections 23, 24, 25 and 26 Township 1 South, Range 30 East W.M. Thence running

in a Northeasterly direction approximately 1425 feet to Section 178 X60 of the said survey,

which Station is approximately 1320 feet East of the Section corner which is common to

Sections 23, 24, 25 and 26 Township 1 South Range 30 E.W.M., said parcel of land contain-

ing 1.96 acres, more or less.
