Beginning at a point North 819.9 ft.; thence N66°-22' W--106.35 ft. from the Southeast corner of Section 33.; Tp. 6 N.R.35 E.W.M. which point is on the south right of way line of the O-W-R-& N. Company railroad; and running thence S 83°-38' W--98 ft; thence N 66°-22' W--170 ft.; thence N 36°-22' W -98 ft.; thence S 23°-38' W--22 ft.; thence S 36°-22' E-98 ft.; thence S 66°-22' E-180 ft.; thence thence N 83°-38' E--98 ft.; thence N 23°-38' W--22 ft. to the point of beginning.
