

Field Notes of Proposed Road
of Public Easement petitioned for by Anti-Hanula

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Pendleton, Oregon, Nov. 28th 1899.

By Order of the County Court for Wasatch County Or.
at the regular Term for Nov. 1899 and dated Nov. 10th 1899
I met J. A. Christopher E. J. Meiser and John W. H. Bademan
Viewers on the 27th day of Nov. 1899 at the Commencement
of the Proposed Road of Anti-Hanula. Who were duly sworn
and subscribed to the necessary oath before me. after which we
proceeded to lay out said Road, commencing at the N.E. cor.
of the SW 1/4 Sec 15 in T4N16S1 E2W1M at Stake marked R.
Thence running East 9.95 chains Thence N 27° 30' E 9.60
chains. Total 19.55 chains to the Public highway running
NW and SE through NE 1/4 Sec 15 T4N16S1 E2W1M set Stake
marked R.T. at intersection of said Public highway.
