On this day comes C. H. Prescott^{2nd} and presents to the Court his petition herein filed, praying for the vacation of all that part of "Garfield Street" from the Eastern boundary of "Third Street" to the Eastern boundary of "Fourth Street"

all of "Fourth Street" from the North boundary of "Lincoln Street" to the North boundary of "Garfield Street" all of "Fifth Street" from North boundary of "Lincoln Street" to South boundary of alley running within Blocks ten^{and} fifteen - All of "Sixth Street" between North boundary of "Lincoln Street" and the South boundary of alley in blocks ten^{and} fifteen aforesaid.

And it appearing to the Court that said petition was duly made^{and} filed in this Court more than thirty days prior to this day, and that due notice of the pendency of said petition and this application has been given for thirty days, by posting written notices containing a description of the property to be vacated set up in three of the most public places in said Town of Centerville. And it appearing to the Court from the circumstances stated in said petition that it will be necessary for the appropriation of the property adjoining said streets to the use for which it is intended, that the streets in said petition named shall be vacated, and it further appearing from said petition that the only person interested in the property to be vacated thereby, is the said petitioner C. H. Prescott trustee, and the Oregon Railway & Navigation Company and no opposition having been made to said petition, or the vacating of the streets aforesaid.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that the streets in said petition, to-wit: All that part of "Garfield Street" from the Eastern boundary of "Third Street" to the Eastern boundary of "Sixth Street". All of "Fourth Street" from the North boundary of "Lincoln Street" to North boundary of "Garfield Street". All of "Fifth Street" from the North boundary of "Lincoln Street" to the South boundary of the alley running within Blocks ten^{and} fifteen - All of "Sixth Street" between North boundary of "Lincoln Street" and the South boundary of Alley in blocks ten^{and} fifteen aforesaid, be^{and} the same hereby are vacated^{and} restored to, and the title thereto re-vested in him the said C. H. Prescott, trustee or his grantees.
